President's Report: Kelly Peebles has found contacts to get money from the state of New Mexico to help put on the Rodeo School in August. Sandia Trailers wants to display some of their trailers at the arena and place an ad in our program. We briefly discussed last months meeting because we did not have quorum, this helped to bring everyone up date.

The report was voted on and passed.

Secretary's Report: Ken Hogg handed out copies of last months minutes and time was taken to review them, this was done because as stated earlier we did not have quorum so

we could not vote on anything at the last meeting.

Trustee's Report: Bob Pimentel told everyone about Wayne Jakeno's condition, he may only have a few months to be with us. Rodeo Committee Report: Jeff Lowe talked about a new buckle design and passed around a picture of the proposed buckle. Jeff announced the Grandmarshall's for the Rodeo this and they are Dan and Mickey. Several stockcontractor's are still being considered. A new contractor was contacted but they were way to expensive, they were going to charge 12,000.00 plus. As of this date only 2 contractors are even in the running, Ronny Meade and Mike

being considered and both will be around 8,000.00 give or take a few dollars.

The new buckle design was voted on and passed.  
The Committee Report was voted on and passed.

Treasurer's Report: Keith Holtzclaw paseed out his report statement showing the amount in our account as of June 12th 2007 which is 10,768.45, he reminded us that there are several buckles still available for people to sponsor and the dead line for putting ads in the program is fast approaching so if you have groups or business's who wish to place an ad please get that information to the board as soon as posible.

The report was voted on and passed.

Old Business---- We still need people with a NM Alcohol server card to help sell beer at the Rodeo.

New Business----- The Beer Blast on July 1st starting at 3 and going until 6 at Sidewinders Bar.
